NDA Urges Senate Action on Workforce Development Bill

This week, NDA sent a letter to the Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions to urge them to take action on legislation to improve the workforce development system. Earlier this year, the House of Representatives passed H.R. 6655, A Stronger Workforce for America Act, which reauthorizes the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and updates federal workforce programs for the first time in ten years. However, the Senate has not yet taken any steps to pass this legislation or introduce their own legislation to reauthorize the WIOA law.

NDA stressed the pressing need for the Senate to pass workforce legislation that will boost skills development, build stronger connections between employers and the workforce system, and put more individuals on track to a successful career. NDA highlighted its support for:

- new employer tax credits to recruit and train workers;
- improved programs for career and technical education; and
- enhanced apprenticeship and job training opportunities.

NDA will continue to lobby the Senate to take action on workforce development legislation in the coming weeks.
